SUBJECT: response to Your inquiry, directed  
to the president of the Government  
of Montenegro

President of the Government of Montenegro comrade Milo Djukanovic has referred Your inquiry to the Ministry of Interior (MUP) of Montenegro with a request to inform You on the whereabouts of Your husband as well as why was he arrested.

Your husband, Titoric Alemko from Novo Sarajevo was arrested on 26 May 1992 in Herceg-Novi, together with another 34 persons, and on request of the Republic of Srpska (Serbian Republic) of Bosnia and Herzegovina (BiH) delivered to the authorized officers of SUP (police) Srebrenica – Petar Mitrovic and Predrag Perendic. On the same day he was delivered to the military police of the territorial defense headquarters (TO) Bratunci, where he was supposed to make part of the group of Muslims intended for exchange for imprisoned Serb territorial fighters.

We do not have further information on the destiny of your husband or on other persons who were delivered to military authorities in Bratunac.
